INTRODUCTION

This document has been produced following consultation in Newstead during Spring/Summer of 2007. The consultation was conducted by the Newstead Parish Plan Steering Group supported by Newstead Parish Council and Rural Community Action Nottinghamshire. The Steering Group was successful in acquiring a £3500 grant from the Nottinghamshire Community Foundation to produce a Parish Plan.

In 2007 a questionnaire was distributed to all households in Newstead and returned by 176 households. In addition young people and children were consulted. On 3rd June 2008 approximately 60 residents attended an action planning event to take forward the findings of the consultations.

The following action plan is an outcome of that day.

Parish Plan Achievements So Far:

- Parish plan has been printed and a copy delivered to EVERY house in the Parish.
- The Parish Plan is also available to view at www.newsteadvillage.org
- Treefest responded to concerns over racism in the Parish by celebrating multi-culture at Treefest 2009.
- The Multi-Use Games Area (MUGA) money was raised and was installed next to the youth club & Surestart centre at the end of September 2010. This facility offers a safe and flexible outdoor space for the young people of Newstead.
- The pit tips have been purchased with monies raised from Greater Nottingham Partnership and now Future Newstead, CAST & RCAN are working to develop Newstead & Annesley Country Park.
- There has been an increased police presence in the village and both police & PCSO contact information is now available in the community café.
- A comprehensive list of doctors who accept Newstead residents has now been published in the village newsletter.
- Smart Water Scheme has been introduced.
- BBC Village SOS Big Lottery Project is helping to highlight the image of the village using local and national media.
- Bulb Planting around the war memorial.
- Cemetery car park – surfaced and landscaped.
- Links were established with Underwood Cricket Junior cricket team now play with children from Underwood.
- Church Mosaic completed in church grounds.
- Newstead Miners Welfare car park improvements.
- Country park development of tracks and roadways, erection of hides, hedging and fencing.
- Village Green safety improvements car park creation.
- Village Green Landscape Preparation and planting of beds.
- Hopping Hill creation of meadow and old cemetery car park.
- Newsletter, notice board and websites all used to communicate information about the village.
- Monthly baby weighing clinic at Surestart Childrens Centre
- Fruit and vegetable van delivery scheme provided at Surestart Centre, Thursday Afternoon
